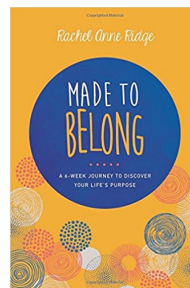
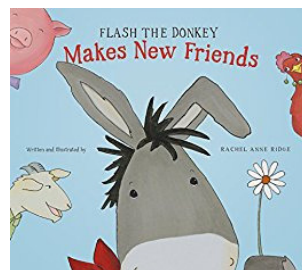
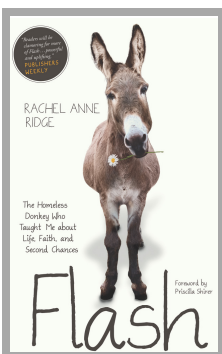
ABOUT
